- What does Dan Cahill collect at the start of the book?
   Rubbings of tombstones
- 2. What is important about Dan Cahill's bag?
  It had all his prized possessions especially the picture of his parents who died.
- 3. Who was the children's guardian?

  Aunt Beatrice who was trying to take everything that was theirs.
- 4. What decision did the relatives need to make at the funeral?

  They had 5 minutes to decide if they would take the million dollars or accept the clue that would lead them to an important treasure.
- 5. What did Aunt Beatrice tell them to do about the challenge? She told them to take the money so she would have control of it.
- 6. Who was the executor of the will?
  Mr. McIntyre an attorney for grandmother
- 7. Why did Amy decide to take on the challenge?
  Grandmother's specialties were adventures. She thought about Grace and new that Grandmother (Grace) had been preparing her for this adventure.
- 8. How many teams decided to take the challenge? Seven
- 9. What was the warning that grandmother had Mr. McIntyre give Amy and Dan? Beware the Madrigals
- 10. What are the four houses/branches of Cahills? Ekaterina, Janus, Tomas, and Lucians
- 11. Where did Amy have them go to find the answers to help them get started?

  To look in the history books in grandmother's secret library they needed to look for the crest to get in
- 12. What did Uncle Alistar invent that made him rich? The microwavable burrito
- 13. How did they enter the secret library?

  They pressed the "C" on the crest that Dan found climbing up the shelves.

Ben Franklin

- 15. What color ink did Amy and Dan's mother always write in? Purple

- 17. What happened to the library?

- 24. Where did the clue from the Franklin Institute lead Amy and Dan? Paris, France

25. How did the kids and Nellie get through customs with Saladin?

45. What was important about the sheet music found with the vial?

It was "Adagio for Armonica". Dan and Amy's dad use to play it all the time when they were young.

46. Where were the children heading at the end of the book?
